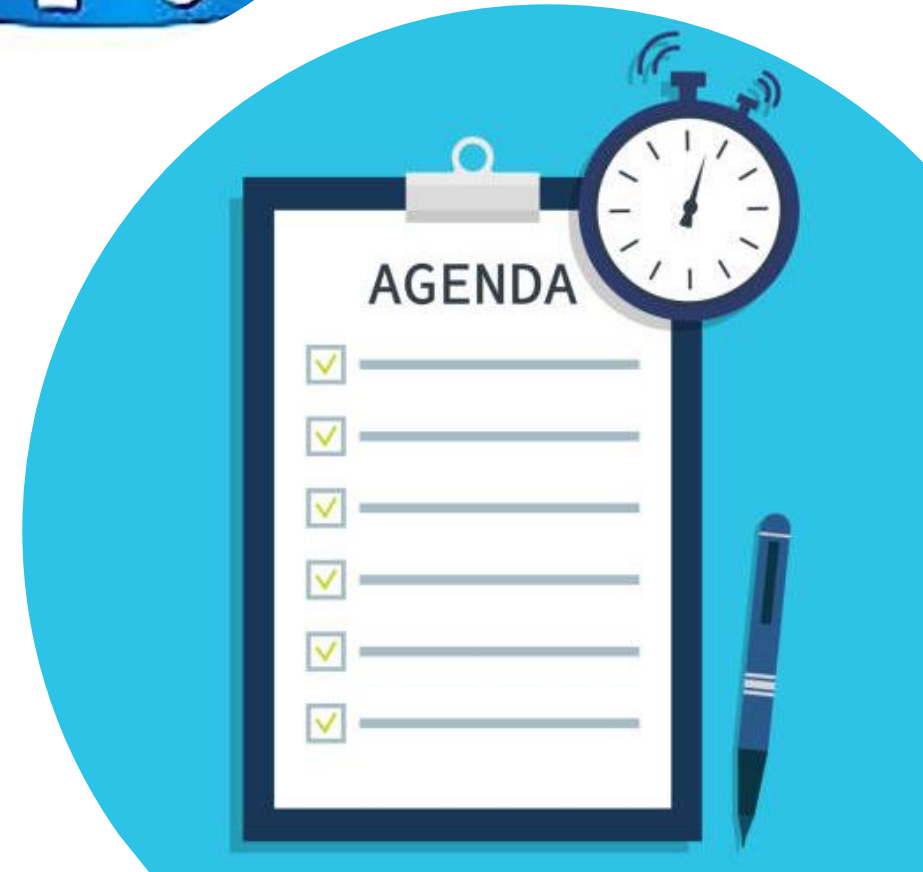
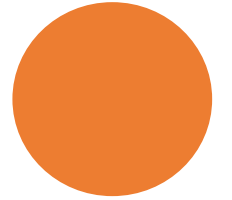

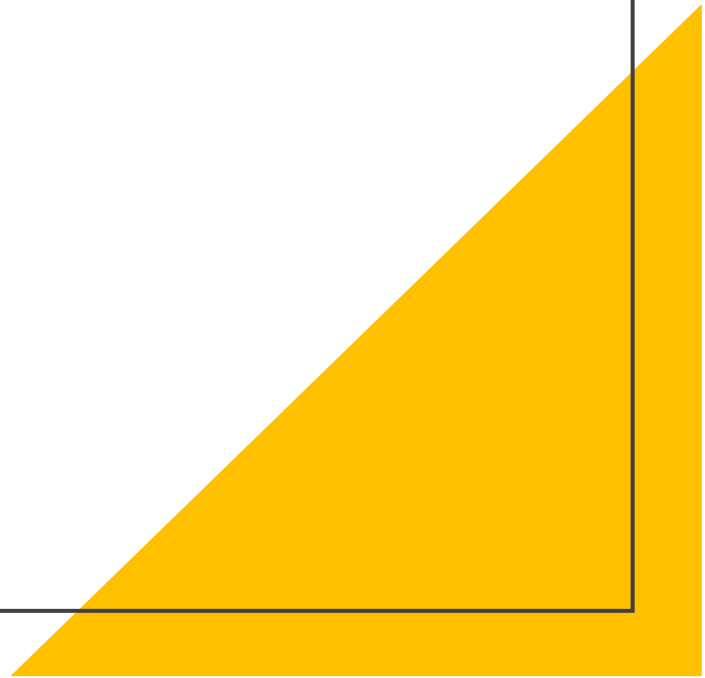
PURPOSE OF CLUB

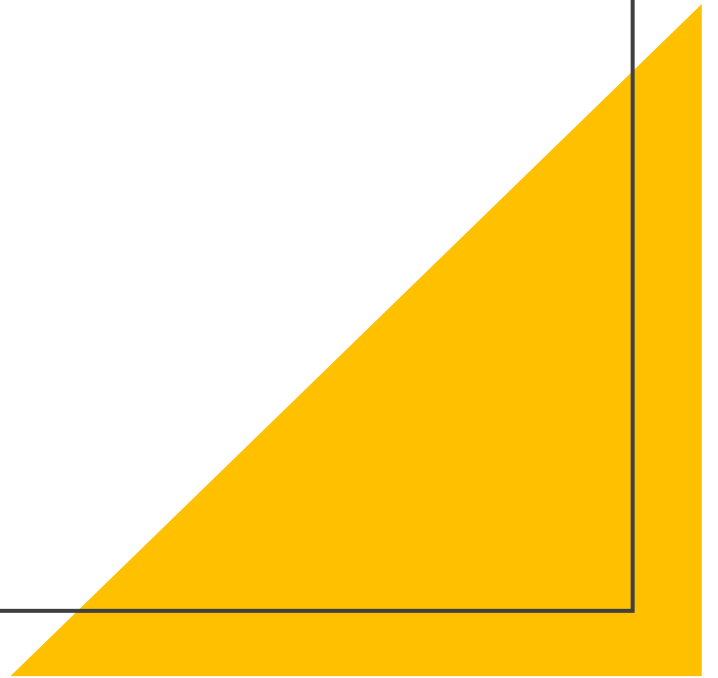
