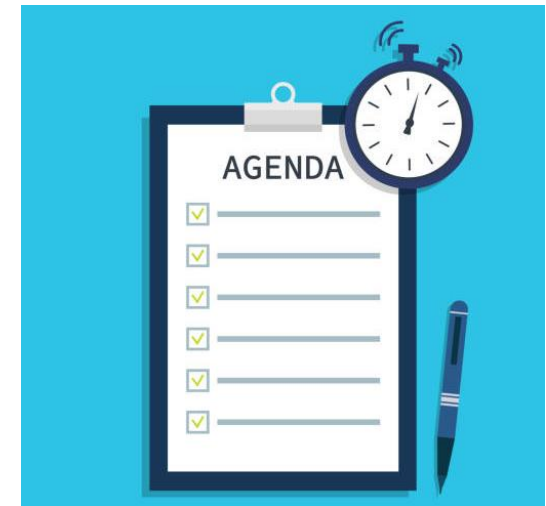

The Ice Facility in Surprise

* ICE purchased 400,000 square-foot warehouse in a residential community located at: 13290 W Sweetwater Ave, Surprise, AZ.

- Proximity to Primrose School is $\frac{3}{4}$ mile.
- City spokeswoman, Virginia Mungovan, said the city wasn't notified prior to purchase.



ICE confirms it will add 1,500-bed detention facility in Surprise

One day after The Republic reported it, records showed DHS bought a 418,400-square-foot warehouse for over \$70 million in cash, finalized Jan. 23.
