The Treasurer was extremely diligent in the maintenance of the financial records and in safeguarding the Club’s resources.

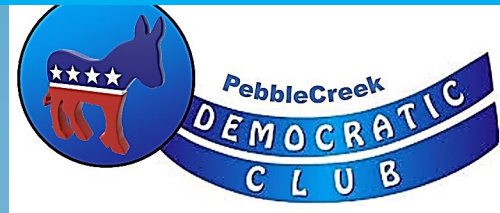

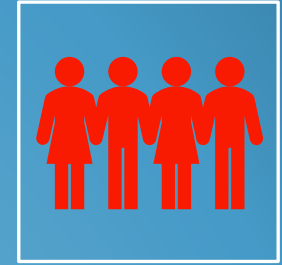
